

## **Rules for visitors concerning the maintenance of the sanitary regime**

1. When purchasing Entry Passes through the on-line system, the person making the reservation is required to provide his or her telephone number in addition to the names of the tour participants. If the Entry Passes are purchased on-site, on the day of the visit (Visitor Service Desk), the purchaser is obliged to provide the telephone number of each person accessing the Museum premises as well as the first and last names of the tour participants.
2. Keep a safe distance while waiting for entry to the Memorial.
3. Visitors enter the Museum area with their mouth and nose covered, in a manner applicable in the Republic of Poland, and are obliged to disinfect themselves in the sanitary sluice, which will ensure disinfection of the outer surfaces of clothing (if possible) or in the available equipment for contact-free hand sanitization
4. Visitors should go through the temperature measuring station (if possible).
5. Visitors are required to disinfect their hands in a contact-free hand disinfection unit in front of the security control point.
6. Security inspection of incoming persons shall be carried out at a safe distance between the person being inspected and the inspector.
7. Movement within the buildings should occur along a one-way road, avoiding crowds in the passageways.
8. Keep safe distances during the tour.
9. Transfer (applies to individual visitors in the so-called "guided tours") between the former Auschwitz I and Auschwitz II-Birkenau camps take place in compliance with the security procedures in force on the territory of the Republic of Poland relating to public mass transport.
